

THE LAKE DOSTER MEN'S GOLF ASSOCIATION

The primary objectives of the Lake Doster Men's Golf Association are to promote and encourage competitive golf programs, to provide golfing contacts among the members and to provide golf handicaps to implement such programs. We invite you to join if at all interested. The LDMGA sponsors golf events throughout the summer. These events include the weekly Tuesday league, 7 Saturday events, 7 two day tournaments and 8 mixed events. The next page gives the schedule for these events. We believe you would enjoy the opportunity to meet and play with the members of LDMGA. All men who have season memberships to the Lake Doster Golf Club are welcome to join LDMGA. We would be pleased to have you join us.

TUESDAY LEAGUE

This is a nine hole weekly league played from early May until late August for 16 weeks of competition. The format has been individual net Stableford points using 1 00% of the player's handicap with a maximum of 23 points allowed. The league nine may be played anytime on Tuesday, but tee times are blocked out from 4 to 6 for the majority of league play. Special (optional) two man events are run each week along with the league with a separate entry fee and pay out.

INFORMATION MANUAL

The LDMGA publishes an "Information Manual" which gives the objectives of the asociation and describes the tournamients and rules, along with phone numbers for all members.

DUES STRUCTURE

The basic dues for LDMGA are \$50 to be paid by the first day of Joey The Jet Derby, our first major tournament. For new members in 2010, dues are \$25. You must be a paid member of LDMGA to participate in the tournaments (and, to win any prizes). The dues include membership in the Golf Association of Michigan which handles our handicap system. Also included is "hole-in-one" insurance which credits \$150 to ward your celebration if you score a hole in one at Lake Doster.

The LDMGA issues a newsletter 8 to 10 times a season which is sent out on the internet with a few printed copies for those without email. Budget permitting, we also purchase items to make the course or club house area more attractive or playable.

The Tuesday league membership is an additional \$20 for the 16 week season. Each tournament has an entry fee, varying from \$10 for most Saturday events to \$400 or so for the Member-Guest event.

A membership application is on the second page of this newsletter.

SENIOR LEAGUE

Golfers, 55 and over, whether they are members of LDMGA or not, play each Wednesday morning in an informal weekly event, followed by donuts and coffee (included in the \$5 entry fee). Teams are made up by lottery after everyone arrives prior to the tee time.

BLOODY MARY SCRAMBLE

This is the first event of the season. It is held on a Saturday in early April (April 4 this year) so the weather is unpredictable. Three man scramble teams are selected by the tournament committee to mix golfers of various handicaps and new and old members. The entry fee is usually \$5 with prizes paid to the top few finishers. This event is open to all men who wish to play. You do not have to be a member of the LDMGA.

The annual spring general membership meeting of LDMGA is held on this same day, preceding golf, while the weather warmst

GOLFER OF THE YEAR

The golfer of the year is decided by a point scheme as descibed in the Information Manual. Each time a member plays in an LDMGA event and is on the winning team, he gets points based on his finish and the type of event. The season winner receives a sizable discount on the membership for the coming year.

JOEY THE JET DERBY

This is the first two day tournament. Two man teams play net best ball for the two 18 hole rounds using 90% of handicap. The prize for 1st place has been single memberships to the Lake Doster Golf Club for the following year. Other leading teams are awarded substantial gift certificates. This is a popular and fun event.

CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP

This is a match play tournament flighted and played by handicap except for the championship flight which plays scratch from the blue tee markers. Trophies are awarded to all flight champions at the fall banquet.

PRESIDENT'S CUP

This is an annual 36 hole individual event with a gross division and a net division. The winners have their names engraved on a standing trophy as well as a personal trophy. The presentations are made at the fall banquet.

SATURDAY EVENTS

On two Saturdays each month, excluding major events, we play an organized 18 hole tournament. Sign up is required, usually by the preceeding Thursday evening. The teams are usually 4 man and selected by draw. The entry fee is usually \$10 with 3 to 5 places paid depending on the number of entrants.

MEMBER-GUEST TOURNAMENT

This two (or three, optionally) day event is planned to give all participants a pleasant time both golfing and socializing. The entry fee includes drinks and lunches for the players as well as food for four on Saturday evening. There are many special door prizes and, usually, a chance to win other prizes.

MIXED EVENTS In cooperation with the Lake Doster Ladies' Golf Association, we co-sponsor eight mixed events during the summer. Most are held on Sundays. The format varies with some using husband-wife teams and others using couples selected by draw. You may sign up as a single with the possibility of being matched with an available lady if you don't have a golfing spouse.

MEMBER-MEMBER(S)

This 36 hole event creates more interest than any other. The format has been 1 day of best ball and 1 day of total net with the total of the 2 days winning the big prize. A Senior Member-Member is held in September played under a different format, usually 2 best balls of a threesome for 2 days.

Reminder: All scores made in an area where the authorized golf association has declared an "active" season must be posted. (At the very least, the last 20 scores, if more were played.) Note: Florida and Arizona are "active" all year.

JOEY THE JET DERBY

You can pick your own partner for competing in this 2 day event. Or, you can sign up as a "Needs Partner". The event will be held on Friday, April 30, and Saturday, May 1. The format is two man best ball using 90% of handicaps for each player. If you do not have an established USGA handicap, you must get in five eighteen hole rounds at Lake Doster by Wednesday, April 28, in order to establish a handicap for the event.

This is one of our major events with a sizable entry fee and sizable prizes including 2011 golf club memberships for the twosome winning the overall first place.

A "GATHERING" SPONSORED BY LAKE DOSTER MANAGEMENT

A special evening for getting acquanted among old and new members is being planned for Tuesday, April 13, at the golf club. Hors d'ouvres will be provided at no cost to members.

GIFT CERTIFICATES FOR 2010

With few exceptions, prizes for golf events will be paid as gift certificates redemable in the pro shop. The club adds 10% to the amount collected from entry fees as a bonus.

A bigger inventory of merchandise in the pro shop has been promised for this season. The arrangement with the Mapel Hills golf outlet in Grand Rapids is being continued.

TUESDAY LEAGUE

League play begins on May 4. Each half will cosist of 8 weeks with your best 5 Stableford scores counting for your ranking in each half and the total of the two halves for overall. The optional \$2 event will be offered each week. "Special Tuesday" events are planned for June 29 and August 31 following each half. These will be formats similar to our usual Saturday events.

The event on April 17 was played as best 2 balls of 4 using 100% of handicaps. With 121 (23 below par), the team of Larry Stratton, Herb Ayres, Hank Norton and Dennis Carman won first. Alan Awe, Billy Martin, Scott Belkofer and Don Meitz had 126 for second. With 127, Bob Sursely, Dean McBeth, Del VanBruggen and Bill Reppenhagen got third.

The event on May 8th was played in ugly weather: cold, rainy and windy. 13 brave souls started the event which was played as 3 of 4 front and 2 of 4 back. Two groups finished the 18 with first place won at 174 (6 under par): Ken Pace, Byron Gonzales and Dennis Carman. The other finishers were Pete Torres, TimVanBruggen and Joe Anderson at 180 (even par).

2010 CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP

The LDMGA Board decided to change the club championship to automatically enter all LDMGA members into this match play event with no entry fee. The membership will be divided into flights of 16 based on the handicap indexes as of Tuesday, June 8. Each flight bracket will be set following the "12. Draw for Match Play" in Appendix 1 of "The Rules of Golf" for 16 qualifiers.

Those golfers with the lowest 16 indexes will play scratch from the blue tees. The next 16 higher indexes will play scratch from the white tees. All other flights will play with handicaps based on the lower man in each match with 100% of the difference going to his opponent. Those 16 golfers with the highest indexes will play from the gold tees. All those in handicapped flights will use the handicap that is current on the day played.

No sign up is needed as all members will be enrolled. HOWEVER, any member who wishes to play in one of the scratch flights, but whose index may not place him there, may volunteer for the change. A signup sheet will be put up for such members to volunteer.

Matches may be played whenever the 2 opponents can arrange them. We will have reserved tee times on Saturday, June 19, , for all the first, or second, round matches that can be played on those days. Please get your matches played ASAP. Winners in each flight will play a total of 4 matches so play needs to move along!

Match play rules are different than our usual stroke play so refresh your knowledge from "The Rules of Golf" booklet. Of importance with this new format may be Rule 2-4, "Concession of Match, Hole or Next Stroke" "A player may concede a match at any time prior to the start or conclusion of that match."....

As you all may know by now, your board has made the decision to enter every member in the club championship. In this way our champions will come from the entire membership. Please check with the pro-shop if you don't know who your first match opponent is. Try to complete your first match in the next week or so. A good time to do this is either on the weekend or during our Tuesday league. If you continue to win, please continue to complete matches in a timely manner. Good luck to all of you.

The board has made another decision concerning the hazard to the right of #6 green. We have decided that we will treat it as a water hazard and not as ground under repair. We recognize the current condition of this hazard is not ideal, but this hole needs to have this hazard in play. The risk/reward for that second shot must be there for this hole to score as it is rated. It is marked as a water hazard. If you find your ball in the hazard and can play it, that is fine. Otherwise you should treat this as a water hazard, using the options available to you under that rule; Rule 26 in The Rules of Golf.

Don't forget Dad. We have a Father's Day event on June 20th. It is a 2 person best ball. There is also a 9 hole division for the kids that will be an alternate shot event. I hope to see you there.

Please take good care of your course. Keep your carts away from the greens and on paths as much as possible. Don't forget to replace your divots, fix your ball mark and one more and have a great time at Lake Doster.

In Stroke Play, (which is how most of our golf is played) there are no "gimmles" allowed. If a competitor fails to hole out and does not correct his mistake before he makes a stroke on the next teeing ground, *he is disqualified.* See Rule 3-2, in "The Rules of Golf" booklet. It is the responsibility of fellow players to see that all balls are holed out and the correct score recorded - "protect the field!"
