2012 CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP

In a change from recent years when all LDMGA members were automatically entered in the club championship, this year, **a sign up by those who wish to enter will be required** with the signup deadline as of Tuesday, June 5. The sign up sheet will be on the bulletin board. There is no entry fee as your LDMGA dues cover the trophy costs.

All LDMGA members are urged to enter this match play tournament.

Flights will be assigned based on the handicap indexes as updated June 1. Those members with the lowest handicaps will be put in the blue tee, scratch flight. The next flight will be a white tee, scratch flight. All entrants with higher indexes will play in handicapped flights. The number of flights and the number per flight will depend on the total entering with the goal being 16 men per flight. The brackets will be set by June 8. They will be posted in the pro shop and sent out by email.

You will be responsible for arranging your tee time with your assigned opponent. Play your first match ASAP, but no later than July 5.

The winners of each match must arrange their next match within 3 weeks or less. In handicapped flights, each player will use his current handicap on the day of the match.

The intent, if there are sufficient entries, is to have a flight made up of the highest handicaps among those entered to compete from the gold tees, using their gold tee handicap.

MATCH PLAY RULES

The rules for match play differ from those for stroke play. Review Rule 2 in "The Rules of Golf". Because of this, it is not desirable to play a match at the same time you are competing in a stroke play event.

One major difference is described in Rule 2-4:

A player may concede a match at any time prior to the start or conclusion of that match.

A player may concede a hole at any time prior to the start or conclusion of that hole.

A player may concede his opponent's next stroke at any time,.....

A concession may not be declined or withdrawn.

Other differences for match play are scattered throughout the "Rules of Golf". See Rule 6-2, Rule 7-1, 7-2, Rule 10-1 (Describes the order of play in matches). Rule 15-3, etc.

The Club Championship is our only event played as individual matches. It is different, but most find it memorable!
