# OFFICIAL 2012 MICHIGAN GOLF SEASON

Despite warm temperatures in Michigan this March, the active handicap season in the state of Michigan is April 1 – Oct. 31. This means you are not allowed to post MICHIGAN scores that are played outside of that date range. If you played golf in a warm-weather state during their active golf season, you must post those scores!

# STROKE ADJUSTMENT RULES Equitable Stroke Control (ESC)

<u>Posting an exceptionally bad score for a hole could change your GAM/USGA</u> <u>Handicap Index too much</u>. If a score on any hole exceeds the limit in the ESC formula, you should, for handicap purposes only, record a score for the hole in accordance with the formula below. There is no limit to the number of holes on which a player can adjust his score.

	MAXIMUM SCORE TO BE
If Your Course Handicap is:	POSTED ON ANY HOLE:
9 or less	Double Bogey
10 - 19	7
20 - 29	8
30 - 39	9
40	10

All of your scores, 9's and 18's, as adjusted, must be posted promptly whether from Lake Doster or away.

The handicaps are updated by GAM on the 1st and 15th of every month. All members are expected to keep their scores posted for handicaps to allow for fair and accurate competition.

## Incomplete Holes or Conceded Strokes

If you pick up on a hole or are conceded a stroke, record the score you most likely would have made. It is the number of strokes (including penalty strokes) taken thus far, plus the number of strokes you think would be needed to complete the hole from that point 50 percent of the time. An X should be placed on the scorecard before such a score.

## Holes Not Played:

When a hole isnt played, your score for the hole is par, plus any handicap strokes to which youre entitled (based on your Course Handicap). And dont let a partial rainout stop you from posting a score. Use this method to fill out your scorecard when you play at least 13 holes out of 18, or at least seven out of nine. An X should be placed on the scorecard here, as well.
